### Wills

#### Introduction

This leaflet is to guide for patients who wish to make a will whilst an inpatient. Please note that this does not replace formal legal advice.

#### Patient's request to make a will

If you request to make a will whilst an in-patient you will be advised to contact a solicitor.

This is so they can complete any necessary capacity assessment as part of their consultation with you.

Medical staff will **not be** able to assess capacity for the purpose of a will.

Citizens Advice will be able to provide you with lists of solicitors if you do not already have one, you can call them on **0800 144 8848**.

#### **Validity**

For a will to be legally valid, the person making it must:

- Be 18 years or older.
- Make it voluntarily with no undue influence or pressure.
- Be of sound mind.
- Make it in writing (hand or type written).
- Sign it in the presence of two witnesses who are both over 18 years old or, if they are unable to sign themselves, direct an individual to sign on their behalf and in their presence.
- Have it signed by the two witnesses, in the person's presence.

### Witnessing wills

Witnesses can be any adult over the age of 18 but **must not** be beneficiaries under the will.

In certain circumstances e.g. when there are visiting restrictions during a pandemic or other infection control concerns, then it may not be possible for somebody to attend hospital to witness the signing of a will. In these circumstances ward staff will contact the Trust Legal Team to explore further options on your behalf.

Members of staff are unfortunately unable to witness the signing of wills.
